

## Miscellaneous Trash/Debris Pickup Policy

Miscellaneous trash/debris pickup will be provided to residents of the City of Lexington as follows:

### A. Acceptable Items

1. Clean Brush – **must be brush only**. No other trash/debris can be mixed in with brush for pickup. Branches, etc. must be less than 12' long. Tree trunks and stumps must be sized for safe pickup by grappler.
2. Furniture, appliances, carpet and household goods.  
Note: Appliances containing Freon must have documentation attached from a certified service repairman that the Freon has been removed.
3. Grass clippings, twigs, hedge trimmings, leaves, pine needles, etc. must be placed in plastic garbage bags for pickup.

### B. Unacceptable Items (Will Not Be Picked Up)

1. Tires  
Note: Tires can be disposed of at the Henderson County Bailer on Rush Street.
2. Shingles, bricks, concrete blocks, dirt, asphalt, gravel and similar items.  
Note: Shingles can be disposed of at the Landfill. Must be weighed and tipping fee paid.
3. Paint Cans, Cardboard, Household Garbage, Construction/Remodeling Debris  
Note: Empty paint cans or paint cans with dried paint may be picked up at the discretion of the department.
4. Debris by Commercial Tree Trimmers and Lawn Care Companies  
Note: May be disposed of at the Landfill.
5. Construction/remodeling debris by contractors and sub contractors  
Note: May be disposed of at the Landfill. Must be weighed and tipping fee paid.
6. Liquid, flammable and hazardous wastes

C. Pickup items shall not be placed under low power, phone or cable lines; in the street or drainage ditches; around fire plugs, utility poles or utility support cables; or in any area that would impede the vision of pedestrians or motorists.

D. Items must not be for placed in wheelbarrows, wagons, carts, etc. for pickup.

E. The City of Lexington shall not be responsible for lost or damaged containers.

F. The City of Lexington reserves the right to refuse pickup of any and all items that are of unmanageable size or provide no means of disposal.

G. Yellow Explanation Tags will be attached to all items not picked up.

H. Final determination of acceptability of pickup will be at the discretion of the Public Works Department.
